Towards Research University

University has good opportunities and potential for development. At the same time if we regard the knowledge triangle:

1) Education. We think University has very good positions in this field.

2) Research. Level of R&D activity need to be enhanced. Lack of money to get new research equipment slows down investigation in modern direction of Science.

3) Innovation. It is the more blind side of the triangle.

Resuming: Insufficient level of Research and Innovation retard the development of Kyiv University. It means our knowledge triangle is unstable.

Triangle must be not only stable! Its sides have to be overlapped.

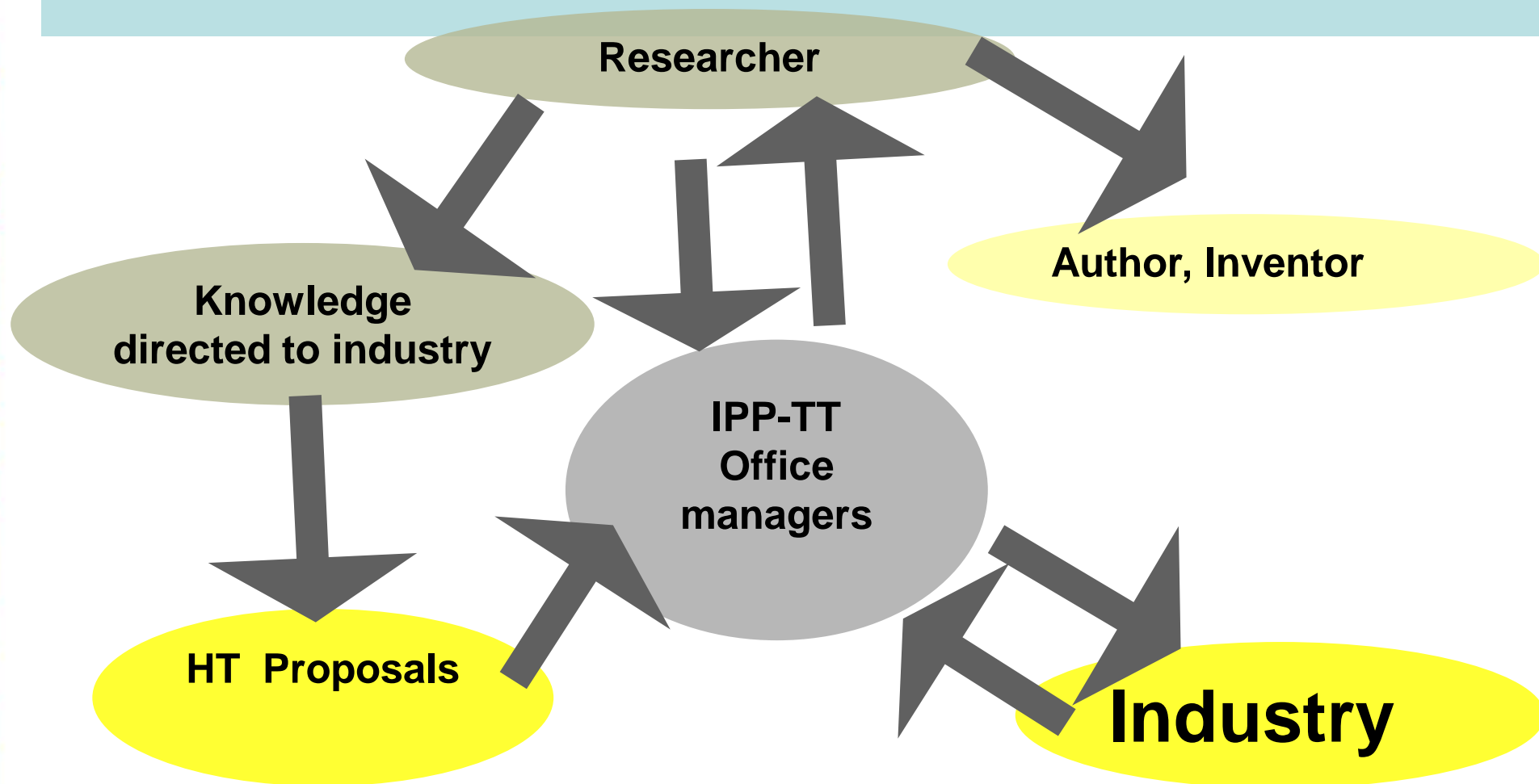

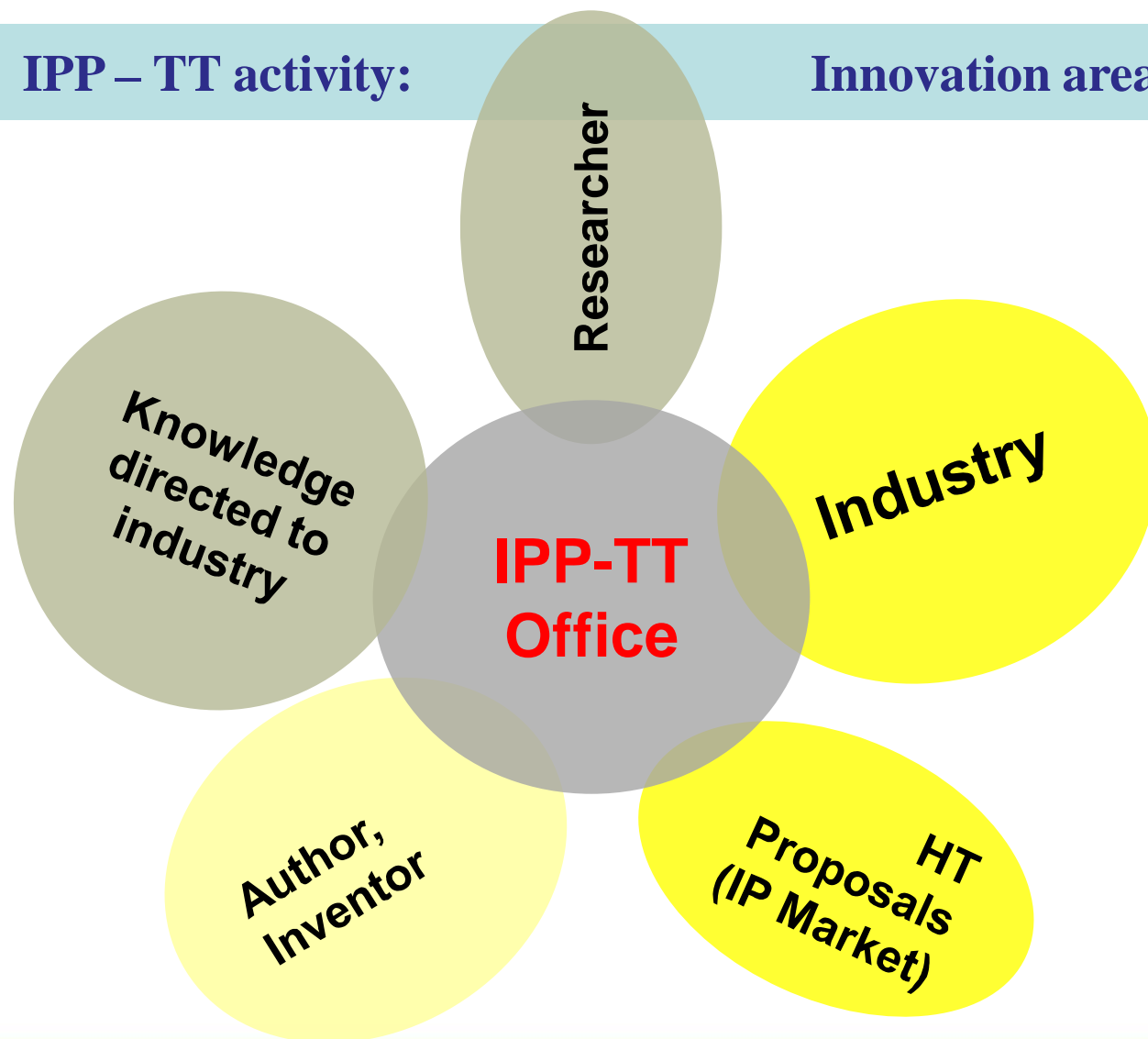
